### **\*Palm or Passion Sunday, April 17, 8am and 10 am**

This liturgy begins with Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem on a road strewn with palms. Jesus' three-year journey ends with the tragedy & triumph of the Cross.



### **\*Holy Monday Eucharist, April 18, 7pm**

An opportunity to gather in quiet meditation upon God's heritage of Presence and Promise to His People.



### **\*Songs of Tenebrae – Tuesday, April 19, 7pm**

Derived from the Latin word for "darkness or shadows".

Musical offering of centuries- old liturgy of darkness overcoming the light... except the one inextinguishable Light: Jesus Christ.

### **\*Historical Eucharist 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Century – Wednesday, April 20, 7pm**

We will celebrate the Eucharist as they did in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Century.



### **\* Maundy Thursday Foot Washing & Eucharist, April 21, 7 pm**

The commemoration of Jesus' institution of the Holy Eucharist, which was preceded by his washing his disciples feet as an example of servanthood to them. The humility of foot washing & the stripping of the altar prepare us for Good Friday.

### **\*Good Friday, April 22**

Liturgy for Good Friday – **Noon to 1 pm**

"Way of The Cross" (Re-enactment of the Passion) - **7 pm**



**Rite of Reconciliation** (Confession) "All may, some should, none must." This is the oft quoted rubric which best explains the Anglican/Episcopalian attitude toward private confession.
